1. What is working well in your committee or group

Front page of website is updated every week.

Requests to add/update web content are completed in a reasonable time frame.

Obsolete content is removed from site in timely fashion.

2. What would you like to change?

Would like to support committees in publishing documents and forums for discussion of church business.

Church calendar is inadequate and needs to be updated. I (Dan Secrest) have suggested using Google Small Business tools, while others are looking at Power Church for this.

Would like to add more content to website. Need more people to contribute information.

3. How are communications working? Could you improve?

Basic technical details regarding web hosting service, domain name, email service, and Yahoo forums have been documented and distributed to informal computing committee.

Website Committee is informal, consisting of Dan Secrest, Glenn Maxwell, and Len Zettel. Could use more members.

4. Summary of Past Year

- The website was cleaned up, with all obsolete pages being removed.
- The church mission was added as a header on every page.
- The front page was restructured, adding "New on the Website", a link to a UUA banner, and links to new content items.
- The **Faith Development** portion of the website was updated with hundreds of pages of material, categorized according to the preferences of the Faith Development Director, with some content password protected.
- Navigation buttons were standardized and added to most pages.
- A standard footer was added.
- Many different sections of the website were updated, both in content and appearance. Some examples:
